Message from the Principal

Kia ora koutou katoa,

As we reach the end of Term 3, I want to take a moment to wish everyone a wonderful and restful break over the next two weeks. It's a great time to enjoy some extra moments with your tamariki before we head into the final stretch of the school year.

This week, our Year 6 students participated in a fantastic Bike Safety Course. They honed their skills through fun practice activities and bike games on the courts before taking to the streets to put those skills to the test. It was great to see them learning while having so much fun!

Today's mufti day was a fun way to finish the term, all funds raised are going toward the senior courts upgrade. Our hardworking fundraising team has made excellent progress on this project, they aim to raise at least \$25,000 by the end of the year. Their next big fundraiser is the Golf Day, and any donations towards this would be greatly appreciated!

The leadership team is now focused on planning for 2025. We're in the process of organising class groupings for next year, which is always a challenging but important task. Our goal is to create balanced classes, both socially and academically. Teachers have already spoken with students and gathered their friend requests, and we'll use this information to ensure that each child has some friends in their new class.

Meanwhile, renovations on the senior classrooms are well underway. Scaffolding has gone up this week, and we expect the roof to be removed during the holidays. We hope the bulk of this work will be completed in time for Term 4. A temporary wall will be put up in the senior classrooms, allowing the contractors to continue working without too much disruption to our students.
