
Lion Poem:

We learnt about what an acrostic poem is. An acrostic poem is a poem in which certain letters of each line spells out a word, name, or phrase when read vertically.


We started by making a class poem about the Lion King. We had to think of words that related to Lion King and started with the right letters. Once we understood what an acrostic poem was, we did our own poems.

We hope you enjoy reading some of our published acrostic poems:



















