Board Meeting Recap - Last Tuesday, our Board of Trustees held a meeting where we received insightful presentations on the interventions from the last term. We're thrilled to report significant progress for many of our intervention students. The Board heard from our English Language Learners (ELL) team about their programme. These focused sessions with students whose first language is not English are well received by our students and we are seeing some tremendous improvement, a testament to the hard work and dedication of both students and staff.

Policy Updates and Feedback - We're currently reviewing several key policies, including those related to concerns and complaints, and the staff code of conduct.
